# Client ELIGIBILITY



Lack of access to supports can have a serious and lasting impact across all areas of a child's life. Leaving children without support contributes to school dropout, unemployment, and involvement with the juvenile justice system.

## FAMILY ENGAGEMENT

Family Navigator - Partners with Families Program provides **free supportive services** to parents and guardians of youth involved with Monmouth County's juvenile justice system. We provide the following free services to youth and families:

- Advocacy
- Assistance with navigating the juvenile justice system
- Linkages and referrals to community resources and support services
- Education and insight through peerbased support and advisory groups
- Family partnerships to identify gaps in system processes, providing recommendations for improvement
